Charles and Phyllis Kinder Scholarship

The Charles and Phyllis Kinder Scholarship was established at the First United Methodist Church of Clermont on January 13, 2003. The sole intent of this scholarship is to honor and recognize ONE graduating high school senior who is a full member of and has made **significant** contributions to the First United Methodist Church of Clermont.

The first Charles and Phyllis Kinder Scholarship was given to a member of the 2003 graduating class. Each year, this scholarship will be awarded on an appropriate Sunday during the church's morning worship services.

Each graduating high school senior desiring to be considered for a scholarship shall submit an application to the church office by March 31, 2012.

The scholarship recipient shall be selected by the Scholarship Committee of F.U.M.C., Clermont. Each year the Scholarship Committee shall evaluate the applications received and determine the amount of money to be awarded. The Scholarship Committee may choose to award no scholarship in any given year.

All scholarship money will be sent to the college or school, not to the scholarship recipient. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to advise the church office of the name and address of the financial aid or other office where a check should be sent.
