

# WHAT TO BRING TO SUMMER CAMP

## Clothing

Scout Field Uniform  
Class A Shirt and shorts, belt, socks, hat  
2 Class B Uniform shirts (troop T-shirt)  
OA sashes, if you have them  
Troop hat and other scout hats  
Other Scout related shirts (Total 5-7 shirts)  
10 pr. Underwear  
10 pr. Socks  
2 pr. Sneakers or boots  
1 pr. Water shoes, shower shoes, or sandals  
3 pr. Shorts (No Denim or cotton)  
1 pr. Long pants (No Denim or cotton)  
2 bathing suits  
2 towels  
1 poncho or rain suit (not the \$1 type)  
1 long sleeve shirt or light jacket

## Camping gear

Mess kit and Utensils  
Sleeping bag, sheets or blanket  
Day pack  
Footlocker  
First aid kit  
Water bottle or canteen  
Flashlight and extra batteries  
Plastic drinking cup with closed handle  
Insect repellent  
Sun screen  
Mosquito netting  
Pocket knife (no sheath knives or blades over 4")  
Sunglasses  
4 large outdoor garbage bags  
6 (gallon size) Ziplock bags  
Camp Chair  
Patrol Flags

## Optional

Pillow  
Board Games, sports gear, Frisbee, etc.  
Musical instrument  
Compass  
Camera and film (disposable recommended)  
Bible/prayer book  
Small metal mirror  
Lantern for tent (battery operated only)

## Toiletry Kit

Toothbrush  
Toothpaste  
Soap in container  
Deodorant  
Comb/Brush  
Shampoo  
Washcloth

## Medication

Prescription and/or Allergy medication  
All medication must be in original, labeled containers  
All medication will be held by Troop leaders or Camp medical staff

## Advancement items (in ziplock bags)

Scout handbook  
Merit Badge pamphlets  
Writing items, paper, tablets, pencil/pen  
Completed projects for Merit Badges

## Money

\$5/day max (for drinks, ice cream, etc.)

## Jewelry

Watches only. Please do not send expensive watches. **No other jewelry allowed.** We cannot be responsible for lost items, and other jewelry is not appropriate for certain activities.

## WHAT NOT TO BRING

*Please do not bring any of the following items. They will be collected and returned to parents at the end of camp.*

- ◆ NO Tobacco of any kind
- ◆ NO Alcohol or Drugs other than prescribed medications
- ◆ NO Fireworks
- ◆ NO Radios, Walkmans, Gameboys, TVs, Pagers or electronics of any kind (except on the bus)
- ◆ NO Jewelry
- ◆ NO Toys
- ◆ NO Shirts, hats or other items with messages/pictures in poor taste, or which are objectionable content
- ◆ NO Sheath knives, Firearms or weapons, except those approved for use in Merit Badge classes, and checked into the camp leaders
- ◆ NO Food that cannot be shared with the group.
